- Leader in "Empowering the Vision" 10 year strategic plan that included notable pieces of public art: Civitas and Mighty Casey.
- Served for 9 years on the Parks, Recreation and Tourism Committee.
- June 2020 featured on the SC ETV program, "Women Vision SC" initiative.
- Former CN2 Hometown Hero.


